# The responsibility of Aquatic Achievers team members

#### Aquatic Achievers team members will:

- Do our best to make sure that you are safe from harm.
- Wear a uniform and/or a name badge so you know who they are.

- Not be alone with you where we cannot be seen by other Aquatic Achievers team members.
- Ask you and your parents/guardians if its ok to take pictures of you.
