The responsibility of Aquatic Achievers team members

Aquatic Achievers team members will:

- Do our best to make sure that you are safe from harm.
- Wear a uniform and/or a name badge so you know who they are.
- Supervise you while you are at Aquatic Achievers.
- Not be alone with you where we cannot be seen by other Aquatic Achievers team members.
- Ask you and your parents/guardians if its ok to take pictures of you.
- Give you guidance that is fair, respectful, and appropriate to your age and background; and
- Help you and other children if you feel unsafe, uncomfortable, or upset.
- Only appropriately touch you to assist you with safety drills or stroke corrections.

Responsibilities of Children at Aquatic Achievers Swim Schools

When you take part in an Aquatic Achievers activity, event, or program you also must behave positively by:

- Telling a team member or parent if you feel unsafe, upset, or uncomfortable.
- Treating other children and adults with respect.
- Following the rules of the activity, event, or program.
